

FAQ's

Q: What is the intro zoom about?

A: The intro zoom is for anyone who wants to come along and find out a little bit more about the Roehampton Trainee Producers course and see if you'd like to apply. It's an informal chat where you can ask questions about the course and find out a little bit more about Emergency Exit Arts.

O: How much does the course cost?

A: The course is totally free to attend! We will also provide you with London Living Wage expenses when you attend a session.

Q: What will I learn on this course?

A: The trainee producer scheme will teach participants a number of skills needed to successfully produce events in the outdoor arts sector and end with the group commissioning an Art Wall on the Alton Estate and throwing a creative launch event to celebrate it.

Q: I've never done anything in the arts before, is this course for me?

A: Absolutely! People with different backgrounds have different ideas and diversity is important in all its forms. If you're interested and want to give this a go, don't let a lack of experience hold you back from applying

Q: Is this course for university graduates?

A: We welcome university graduates but this is absolutely not a requirement. We are looking at interest in the course, previous experience, commitment and enthusiasm!

Q: Where will this course take place?

A: We will have sessions face to face in Roehampton as well as some sessions online over Zoom. To ensure the course is accessible as possible for everyone we will be scheduling our sessions at the time that suits most participants so this is still currently flexible!

Q: How many places are there on the course?

A: We have 12 places for this year's trainee producer scheme

Q: Will I have to do work outside of the scheduled sessions?

A: Yes, while we will cover a lot of information during the sessions all participants will be expected to do tasks between sessions.

Q: I'm 26, can I still apply?

A: Unfortunately, this time round the trainee programme is only open to applicants between 18 and 25 years old.
